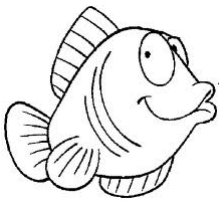


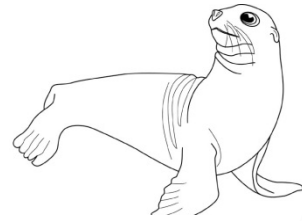
How can I find you? Complete at School

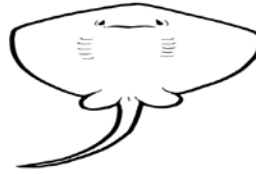

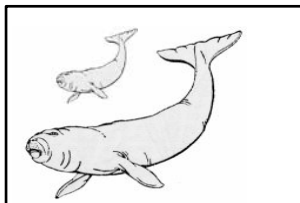
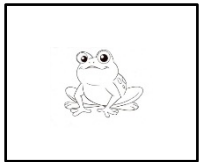
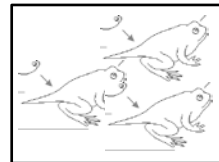
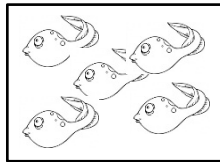
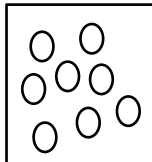
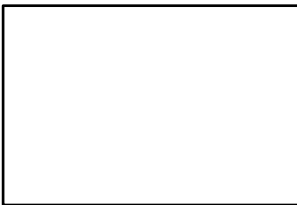
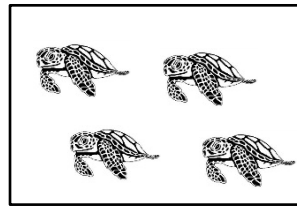
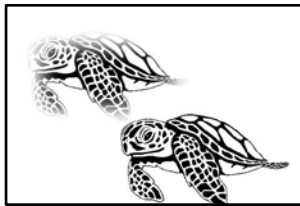


Crab Larvae (baby crab)
