



FAQs & Important Planning Information for Penguin Expedition at SEA LIFE Sydney

Can children go on the boat ride?

- Yes, however to protect the health and safety of our guests, there are a few rules and height restrictions that apply for the Penguin Expedition.
- School groups must have the correct student to teacher ratio, depending on children height restrictions.

How many people per boat?

- Maximum of 6 people per boat.

What are the height restrictions?

- Children under 90cm must be seated next to a responsible adult. (1:1 student -teacher Ratio)
- Children over 90cm but under 120cm must be seated next to or in the row immediately in front of a responsible adult. (3:1 student-teacher ratio)
- Children over 120cm are free to ride without adult supervision.

What safety rules must be followed?

- Guests must remain seated at all times.
- Guest must keep all arms/legs inside the boat at all times.
- Please be quiet, you don't want to scare the penguins away!
- No rocking of the boats.
- Please be respectful of the ride staffs requests, they are here to protect your health and safety.

How cold is the penguin expedition?

- To meet our sub-Antarctic penguins, guests will be transported by boat through a cool yet comfortable six degrees Celsius. We did say that this was an immersive experience!

How long is the boat ride?

- The boat ride through the sub-Antarctic to meet our majestic birds takes approximately 2 minutes from start to finish.

Do I have to go on the boat ride to meet the sub-Antarctic penguins?

- No, guests who do not wish to go on the boat ride can still view our majestic birds from the large viewing windows surrounding the display!
